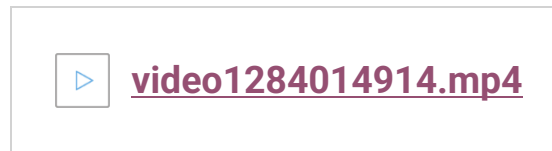
**Minutes of the February 20, 2024, meeting was approved.**
