### **Outdoor Burning Restrictions**

o Burning yard waste, household garbage, and building materials (i.e., scrap wood, paint, vinyl flooring, roofing, and carpet) are prohibited.

- o Recreational fires are generally allowed clean fuel, less than 3 feet in diameter and 2 feet in height, and 25 feet from any structure.
- o Recreational fires are not allowed during a burn ban. Puget Sound Clean Air Agency (pscleanair.org) sets regional air quality bans, and local fire officials set the fire safety ban.
- o WAC 173-425-050 if the smoke from the fire bothers the neighbors or damages their property or otherwise causes a nuisance, the fire shall be extinguished.
